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

Arrival in Colombia

Medellín

Your exciting journey begins at Medellín Airport, where you will be greeted by one of our specialized guides with a warm welcome. Together you will go to the charming hotel selected for your rest and comfort.

During this talk they will share essential information about the exciting adventure that awaits them in the coming days. Flight to Bahía Solano

Arrival in Bahía Solano

A 45-minute flight will take you from Medellín to Bahía Solano, where our staff will be eager to welcome you. Prepare to immerse yourself in the enchanting wonders of the Pacific, as an unforgettable experience awaits you at Darien Lodge, which promises the best of everything.

During the three-hour boat trip in the open sea, you will be able to enjoy the observation of various species, such as the Blue-footed Booby, the Brown Pelican, the Thick-billed Tern, the Slender-billed Phalarope, and depending on the season, the amazing humpback whales and pilot whales.

In the evening, an exciting night safari awaits you that will amaze you with the new world that begins when daylight goes away.





Birding in Punta Ardita North Trail

Early in the morning, we will start the day with the first approach to the birds. During this 6-hour hike in Punta Ardita, you will have the opportunity to delve into the mangrove ecosystem and witness an impressive variety of species, including the White-winged Sandpiper, Northern Barred Nuthatch, Pacific Antbird, and Grackle. Long-tailed Warbler, Northern Water Warbler and Banana Honeycreeper.

Our guide, an expert in bird watching, will carefully select the best place to enjoy lunch in the jungle, ensuring that you are surrounded by the beauty and melodious songs of the most charming bird species. It will be a unique experience to share this moment with nature and listen to the chorus of birds that surround you while you enjoy a delicious meal in the middle of this pristine environment.

The Punta Ardita hike will allow you to explore not only the avian life of the region, but also the lush beauty of the rainforest and mangrove ecosystem. This will be another exciting chapter in your adventure at Darien Lodge, where each step will bring you closer to the amazing biodiversity of this region of the Colombian Pacific. Get ready to live an unforgettable day in the middle of nature!





Mangrove Explore and Visit to the Curiche Community

After breakfast, we set out on a boat journey spanning 15 minutes to reach the Municipality of Jurado. Our course takes us through an expansive mangrove swamp until we reach the opening of the Curiche River.

Here we will be navigating along the Curiche River, guided by an Embera indigenous. This leg of the trip offers a fascinating glimpse of the shift from coastal terrain to dense jungle surroundings.

During our time on the river, we will have the opportunity to exchange greetings with members of the indigenous community, and as we progress, we will traverse a natural trail, where an array of bird species, mammals, amphibians, reptiles, and medicinal plants come into view, creating a remarkable tapestry of biodiversity







Trekking Along the Ardita's South Trail

Please make sure you have all your luggage ready for check-out before 8am.

Our day will begin with a walk along the southern trail of Punta Ardita, allowing us to once again witness the lush and vibrant nature that protects the Darien jungle. Around noon, we will return to the Lodge for lunch before making our way back to Bahía Solano.

We will make a stop at the impressive natural wonder of Cabo Marzo, a unique natural aquarium that adorns this Pacific coast. In this extraordinary place, we will participate in a snorkeling activity that will give you access to the amazing marine kingdom. Our day will end when we arrive at the Costa Choco hotel, where we will find rest and end our activities.

This day will be full of adventure and exploration, from the morning walk in the jungle to the immersion in the crystal clear waters of Cabo Marzo. It will be a unique opportunity to experience the rich terrestrial and marine diversity of this region. So make sure you're ready for an exciting day full of discovery on your trip to the Colombian Pacific coast.







Flight to Medellín

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Comfortable and climate-appropriate clothing: Quick-drying clothing.
- Appropriate Footwear: Wear comfortable, sturdy shoes, and consider waterproof hiking boots for rough terrain.
- Sun protection: Wear high-factor sunscreen and a widebrimmed hat or cap to protect yourself from the sun.
- Insect repellent: Bring insect repellent to avoid bites.
- Binoculars and camera: Bring binoculars to observe animals and a camera to capture special moments.
- Water bottle and snacks: Stay hydrated with a water bottle and bring energy snacks.
- Field guide to the birds of Colombia, this will help you identify and better understand wildlife during your wildlife watching tour.

VACCINES FOR COLOMBIA

We assume you are up to date with your vaccinations. A vaccination certificate is not required when entering Colombia, however, it is important to keep these recommendations in mind:

There are no major problems with mosquitoes in most reserves. It is recommended to be vaccinated against typhoid fever and hepatitis A. Yellow fever is very rare in Colombia.

Malaria is present in many low-lying areas of Colombia. Although it is not known to exist near our reserves, it is present in some cities in the regions of the Western, Central and Eastern Andes, Magdalena, Santa Marta, Guajira and Chocó. In these areas, it is best to reduce the number of insect bites by wearing long-sleeved shirts and pants, and using insect repellent, especially at dawn and dusk.

Dengue, although not common, is also a possibility, and once again, it is recommended to reduce the risk of insect bites and be aware of the symptoms of this fever.

Leishmaniasis disease, transmitted by sand fly bites, is also a remote possibility in low-lying areas, and again, visitors should learn the symptoms. There have only been rare cases in the communities of the Magdalena Valley, but not within the reserve.

Mites are also found in long grass around the Caribbean coast, away from main routes. Cover your legs, pants, shoes and waist with insect repellent.



CANCELLATION POLICIES

We require written notification of any cancellation, which will be effective upon receipt. If you need to cancel your reservation, you must inform us immediately at **ocampo.wpe@gmail.com** and we will confirm your cancellation.

Depending on the date we receive your cancellation notice, cancellation charges per person will apply. In compliance with the above, the cancellation policies of **OCAMPO EXPEDITIONS** are set as follows:

If OCAMPO EXPEDITIONS has more than 180 days notice, deposit is forfeited unless dates can be resold, in which case a 10% admin fee will apply.

If OCAMPO EXPEDITIONS has between 179 and 91 days notice, 70% of tour costs are forfeited, unless the client can find a replacement. In which case a 10% admin fee will apply.

If OCAMPO EXPEDITIONS has less than 90 days notice, 100% of our costs are forfeited, unless the client can find a replacement in which case a 10% admin fee will apply.

If you fail to join a tour, or join after departure, or leave prior to its completion, no reimbursement whatsoever will be made.

In the event of force majeure, fortuitous event or incapacity of the holder of the reservation or a relative in the first degree of consanguinity, the request for exoneration must be accompanied by the corresponding support (s) and submitted within 15 current days from the initial date of the trip, otherwise the established policies apply.



PRICE INCREASES

As a result of the possibility of many circumstances beyond our control, the total cost of the trip is subject to change, although this is only considered as a last resort. Participants will be notified if there are any changes to the cost of the trip. We do our best to anticipate cost increases in services in each area in which we operate, but when there are unexpected increases, we reserve the right to increase our price by 10% of the trip price. If additional increases are required, participants may withdraw from the tour without incurring cancellation penalties.

If you wish to avoid the cost of a single room (single supplement) we will try to find you a roommate, but please note that this is not always possible and if we cannot find a suitable roommate you will be asked to pay the single supplement. Please note that your accommodation preferences will be honored to the extent possible, but cannot be guaranteed. In some remote locations (e.g. at field stations) this is not always possible and arrangements must be adjusted. When we are aware of these situations, participants will always be informed before making the reservation. When an unexpected change is needed (especially in remote locations where communication is difficult), unavailability at a particular hotel or accommodation is usually not previously reported and is only discovered upon arrival. Under these circumstances, your leader will do everything possible to satisfy the group's preferences.
